Lake Conroe Park Closure

Conroe, Texas—The San Jacinto River Authority (SJRA) announced today Montgomery County has terminated their lease agreement with SJRA for the operation of Lake Conroe Park.

“SJRA has been in a long-term lease with Montgomery County for Lake Conroe Park. Once the termination agreement is finalized, we will explore future operational partnerships,” said SJRA Acting General Manager Ed Shackelford.

Lake Conroe Park, located at 14968 Hwy 105 West, Montgomery, TX 77356, sits on the west shores of Lake Conroe. Building for Lake Park began in 1990 as a partnership between Montgomery County, San Jacinto River Authority, and Texas Parks and Wildlife.

One of the major river authorities in Texas, SJRA's mission is to develop, conserve, plan, and protect the water resources of the San Jacinto River basin. Covering all or part of seven counties, the organization's jurisdiction includes the entire San Jacinto River watershed, excluding Harris County.
